I am requesting funding for Kyrene School District in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Kyrene School District, located at 8700 S. Kyrene Rd., Tempe, AZ 85284.

The funding would be used to install charging infrastructure and expand the capacity to charge 50 fleet vehicles that are used by employees on a day-to-day basis to travel back and forth from the district's 25 school locations.
