3	Section 8(o) of the United States Housing Act of
4	1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437f(o)) is amended by adding at the
5	end the following:
6	"(23) Rental vouchers for high growth
7	POPULATION AREAS.—
8	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall,
9	each year, using amounts appropriated pursu-
10	ant to subparagraph (B), provide additional as-
11	sistance in an equitable manner to each eligible
12	public housing agency for tenant-based assist-
13	ance, based on the population in the area
14	served by the public housing agency, the extent
15	to which existing voucher allocations of the eli-
16	gible public housing agency do not meet its
17	housing affordability needs, and historical
18	shortfalls in providing assistance to such eligi-
19	ble public housing agency as a result of voucher
20	formula allocations not keeping pace with popu-
21	lation growth over the period identified in sub-
22	paragraph (C)(ii).
23	"(B) Authorization of Appropria-
24	TIONS.—There are authorized to be appro-
25	priated to Secretary to carry out this paragraph
26	\$2,000,000,000 for fiscal year 2025, which

1	shall be available for renewals in each fiscal
2	year thereafter until expended.
3	"(C) ELIGIBLE PUBLIC HOUSING AGENCY
4	DEFINED.—For the purposes of this paragraph,
5	the term 'eligible public housing agency' means
6	a public housing agency that administers Fed-
7	eral housing assistance for an area that, as de-
8	termined by the Secretary—
9	"(i) has a population of greater than
10	100,000; and
11	"(ii) is one of 25 areas in the United
12	States that experienced the highest popu-
13	lation growth between 2012 to 2022.".
