I am requesting funding for Valle del Sol Facility Renovation and Expansion in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Valle del Sol located at 3877 N. 7th St. Suite 400, Phoenix, AZ 85014.

The funding would be used for construction and infrastructure activities necessary to renovate and expand the clinical footprint of the Valle del Sol Mesa 334 Health Center facility from 8,341 to 14,428 square feet.
