I am requesting funding for the City of Tempe Grand Canal Connection Construction in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Tempe, located at 31 E 5th St, Tempe, AZ 85281.

The funding would be used for construction of bike and pedestrian improvements providing for the direct and continuous connection of three regional off-street paths that all converge in Tempe: Grand Canal, Crosscut Canal, and the Rio Salado North Bank Path.
