I am requesting funding for Tempe's Recharge Well 4 in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

The funding would be used to provide recharge capacity to store reclaimed water for future recovery from the city of Tempe's water wells. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would maximize water reuse to meet current and future water needs in the city due to the ongoing drought in the Colorado River Basin.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 595 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1999 as amended (Public Law 116-260) and section 219(f) of the Water Resources Development Act of 1992 as amended (Public Law 117-263).
